The Patuxent River (MD) Chapter ("PRC") was established on June 27, 2014 by 48 distinguished and accomplished women from a variety of backgrounds and diverse educational and life experiences. We are dedicated to serving people of color in our local community and abroad. We uphold The Links, Incorporated's mission of enriching, sustaining, and ensuring the identities, culture and economic survival of all people of African origin through cultural, educational, and civic programs. Through our partnerships, the PRC promotes activism to help facilitate positive change that transcends time, racial and socio-economic differences.

Our service programming is developed through the five Facets of The Links, Incorporated: the Arts, Services to Youth, Health & Human Services, National Trends & Services, and International Trends & Services. It is under this rubric that we have developed our two signature programs - G.E.M.S. and our Health & Financial Wellness Event (HFWE).

Through our award winning G.E.M.S. program, we cultivate girls (affectionately known as "Gems") in grades 5-9 into young ladies who are Global-minded, Empowered and Motivated for Success. We have increased opportunities for these promising young ladies to be exposed to STEM, cultural programs and activities, international people and ideas, mentoring, healthy lifestyles/choices, and new approaches to conflict management, resulting in increased self-esteem, self-advocacy and leadership skills. Our structured workshops, field trips, and activities are designed to expose the girls to issues consisting of, but not limited to, combating bullying, understanding and appreciating people of different cultures and backgrounds, knowing and understanding African history and culture, and understanding their voices and the impact they can have on others in the classroom and around the world.

Our Health & Financial Wellness Event has been held biennially. Driven by partnerships within the health and financial communities of Montgomery County, we have been able to provide much needed FREE health information and services including, but not limited to: health screenings for blood sugar and cholesterol by the Kaiser Permanente Mobile Unit; vascular sonograms by MedStar health; dental screenings for children by The Colgate Dental Van; and hearing tests by local doctors. We offer financial workshops on: entrepreneurship coaching; how to start and grow a small business; homeownership opportunities; Home Affordable Refinance Program; money management; debt reduction strategies; retirement planning; and much more.

Additionally, PRC co-sponsors an annual DMV Health Walk and The Red Dress event with other local Links chapters as well as donates hundreds of dollars and supplies each year to a local women's shelter.

As is evident, we are a busy group of ladies. It cannot go without recognition that the glue that holds us together is the very foundation of The Links, Incorporated - **Friendship**. It is through friendship, and nothing less than that, that these 48 women are able to work hard and meet the very high expectations that our community has for us.
